Football Season:

The Squad Moms serve breakfast to the team on Pep Rally Friday mornings following practice. Each squad has a designated date to sponsor the breakfast and each girl is asked to bring a small food item.

Remember the girls cannot eat once they are in uniform. On Home Game Friday afternoons the girls are not allowed to leave the school so it is recommended that you bring them dinner. Make arrangements for another mom to help bring dinner or send food with your Eaglette. It is very important they eat before the games. For Away Games dinner EBC will be willing to pick up dinner for Eaglettes who give money to purchase their dinner from a designated restaurant. Orders will be taken Friday mornings.

Please be prompt in picking up your Eaglette after each football game. The chaperones and director cannot go home until all the girls have left the school. Please be respectful.

The EBC purchases letter jackets for all the New Girls. Team members will not officially letter until the banquet. If a girl does not complete the year she will not receive her letter.

Various groups of Eaglettes perform at pep rallies which are held on Friday mornings. Show your spirit and join the fun at the best pep rallies in Texas!

Tryouts for each football game are held at a time designated by the director (usually Mondays).

Hopefully you have purchased or will purchase season football tickets. We all try to sit together to cheer the football team, band, and of course, our fantastic Eaglettes!

Tailgate parties are held before many of the home football games. Various RHS groups sponsor the tailgate parties and dinner may be purchased for a small cost. Goldline usually performs their kick routine at the tailgate parties.

Homecoming:

Eaglettes march in the homecoming parade. We are the only Richardson school to have a traditional homecoming parade. The parade begins at 4pm on the Friday of the game and travels down Beltline.

The Booster Club enters a float each year. The Eaglettes have won the prize for best float several times, with the prize money going to support the EBC.

Eaglettes sponsor the semi-formal Homecoming Dance on the Saturday night following the big game. The social officers plan the decorations and the EBC helps with the selling tickets, decorating, chaperoning and other duties. The funds raised by the event help fund the Eaglettes many activities throughout the year.

Revue:
